- **1931 - Karachi - Vallabhbhai Patel - Resolution on Fundamental Rights + National economic progress. Gandhi nominated to represent INC in the second round table conference**
- **1936/ 1937- Faizpur - J.L Nehru (First session in a village)**
- **1939 - Tripuri- Subhas Chandra Bose - Bose was elected but resigned + Gandhi support Pattabhi Sitaramayya. Rajendra Prasad was appointed**
- **1940 - Ramgarh - Abul Kalam Azad - Resolution of Individual Satyagraha**
- **1946 - Meerut - J.B.Kripalani**
