- **Vatsa** (Important rulers: **Udayana**)
- **Bimbisara** : 558 BC – 491 BC
- **Ajatshatru** : 492- 460 BC
- **Udayin** : 460 BC - 444 BC
- **Shishunaga Dynasty** (around 413 BCE – 345 BCE)
- **Nanda Dynasty** (First **non-Kshatriya dynasty**) (345 BCE – 321 BCE)

- Capital : **Girivaraja.**
- Work : **Temporarily shifted capital to Vaishali.**
- Achievement : Defeat **Avanti (Pradyota Dynasty)** and make it a part of Magadha.

This brought an the100-year-old rivalry between Magadha and Avanti.
